In Autumn Term 1 we spend lots of time helping the children understand what makes a good listener and speaker. We teach children a range of nursery rhymes and encourage children to join in with familiar stories (using actions and repeated refrains). We encourage children to begin using new (key) vocabulary straight away in their daily language when communicating with others and encourage eye-contact.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

In Autumn term 1 we help children learn how to be responsible and look after our classroom resources and each other by being 'kind'. We teach the children to recognise, manage and talk about their feelings as they begin to self-regulate. We also encourage children to select and use activities (independently) that help them to achieve a goal they are working towards. We spend lots of time helping children learn to share, take turns, follow rules and to solve conflicts in a kind manner. Lots of work is done around building relationships with other children and the staff in the EYFS setting.
