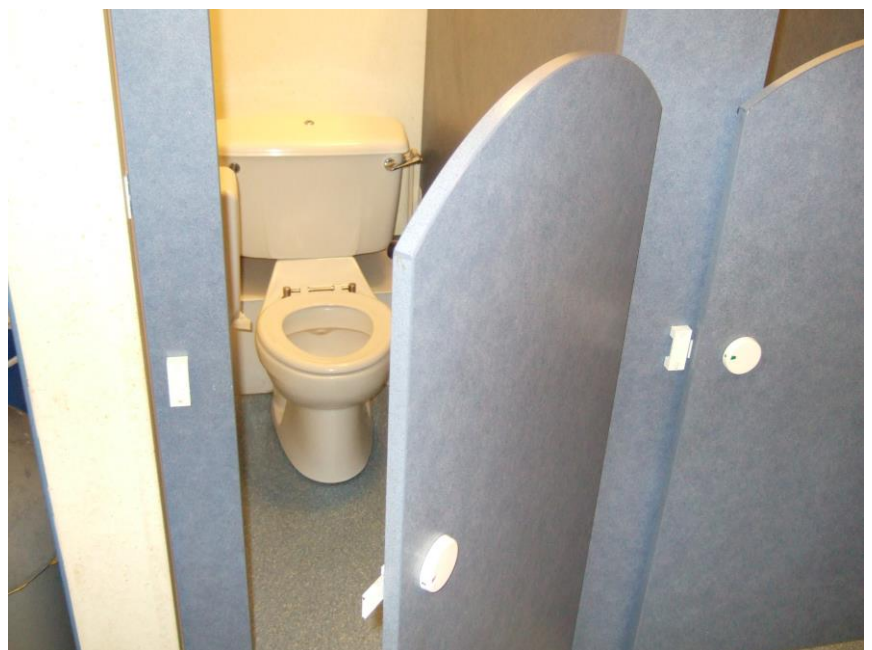




I hang my coat up here.
